## INSTRUCTIONAL BULLETIN#13-32

**TO:** All Fire and Rescue Personnel

RE: DUVAL COUNTY PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL GAMES

The following information contains guidelines that we must follow for safety and success at area high school football games:

- Punctuality is a must for these high school games. The games cannot begin until the EMS staff is present on the sideline. The report time for each game is the time the EMS staffing is to begin its pregame meeting with the Athletic Trainer and Team Doctor.
- Most schools will not have designated parking for JFRD personnel; however, inform the parking attendant when you arrive that you are JFRD and they will put you as close as possible to the field.
- All equipment is located at the schools.
- At the conclusion of the game, you must check with the medical staff for each team to ensure that your services are no longer needed prior to being relieved from duty.
- Your staging area will be on the home team sideline at the 25 yard line. Be sure to discuss this at the pregame meeting with the team's medical staff. When a player goes down, do not respond onto the field. The team medical staff will first respond to all injuries on the field. If it is serious enough, they will call you out to the field. At that time respond with all your equipment to the injured player. Again, **DO NOT RESPOND ONTO THE FIELD FOR AN INJURED PLAYER UNTIL THE TEAM'S MEDICAL STAFF REQUESTS YOU**.
- For radio communication you will be on **A2**. Once you call Fire Communications for assistance, switch to **A3**. Just like on a normal EMS call.

- Remember, you are there to provide EMS for the teams. Be alert and pay attention to the game. We are not there to socialize with the spectators.
- If there is an emergency in the stands and you are notified, inform the trainer or doctor that you are responding to a medical emergency in the stands. Call for immediate assistance and get back to the sideline ASAP.
