RE: **New Cross Lay Hose Lengths**

ISO requires two cross lays on all pumpers to be at 200' in length. Anything more or less gives us a *zero* point credit when we go for the re-rating.

Effective January 24th ---All JFRD pumpers will have two (2) 200' of 1 3/4" hose in the cross lays. The bumper loads and bed loads can be any length determined by the unit captain.

If you require an additional section of 1 3/4" hose to comply with this bulletin, please contact TSF.

It's normal to think if we get credit for 200', then 250' will be better. Unfortunately, the answer is we would get *zero* credit for that cross lay.
