**RE:** **Staffing Policy for Stations 7 and 21**

JFRD is currently one of twenty one State of Florida's state asset teams for hazardous materials regional response. Part of the funding and sustainment requirements for a type II Team is all team members must be trained to the IAFF 160 hour Hazardous Materials Technician level and be state certified.

Effective immediately, the following is required for permanent assignment to any Suppression unit assigned to Station's 7 and 21.

1. 160 Hour IAFF Hazardous Materials Technician Course.
2. State of Florida Hazmat Technician Certification.
3. Additional training as required on duty.

When a vacancy occurs on Suppression apparatus preference will be considered for those already state certified to hazmat technician level.

If no certified personnel request the open spot, seniority will be the guiding assignment principle with a commitment to fulfill the training requirements.
