<u>Jacksonville Fire Rescue Yearbooks-</u>Your copy of the new 2016 JFRD Yearbook is ready for preorder. Price is \$65.00. This price includes shipping to the Union Hall. Pre-orders MUST be completed on or before MAY 19, 2017! It's finally time to pre-order your 2005-2015 'A Decade in the JFRD' memorial book.A few important facts:

The company that is publishing this work deals primarily with High Schools, so some of the questions are geared toward that. You should choose "Other" as the role you are, when prompted.

* Your yearbook costs **\$65.00.** Payment will be through the website at the time of order.

* You'll need to purchase your copy by May 19 in order for it to be in the initial shipping. All pre-orders will arrive near the end of June at one location (not your school!) and be available for pickup either as individuals listed or as a station. Following May 19, all orders will be shipped to the address of your choosing for the same price, plus shipping and handling.

* All purchasing and ordering is done through the Tree Ring website at the provided address, and can be done either individually or as a group. Currently, there is no price difference between single or bulk orders but after the pre-order period, each order will have the same shipping and handling cost, regardless of how many books are on the order, so if stations bundle their order, the single S&H will save money.Get started by clicking on this link:
