In accordance with the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department SOP 212, all Firefighters who receive their "First Assignment" as part of this Informational Bulletin are considered probationary. Firefighters must satisfactorily complete the Civil Service 12-month probationary period and pass the 7-month and 11-month examination prior to becoming a permanent member of the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department.

The 7-month examination shall be completed prior to May 1, 2014, and the 11-month examination prior to September 1, 2014. To assist these members in achieving permanent status, they shall not be transferred, not temporarily assigned to another work location until after they have satisfactorily completed their 6-month examination. In order to accommodate extraordinary staffing circumstances, the Division Chief of Operations may grant exceptions to this restriction on a case by case basis.

ALL TRANSFERS WILL BE COORDINATED THROUGH THE APPROPRIATE BATTALION CHIEF.
