In accordance with the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department SOP 212, all Firefighters who receive their "First Assignment" as part of this Informational Bulletin are considered probationary. Firefighters must satisfactorily complete the Civil Service 12-month probationary period and pass the 7-month and 11-month examination prior to becoming a permanent member of the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department.

The 7-month examination shall be completed prior to September 1, 2014, and the 11-month examination prior to January 1, 2015.

ALL TRANSFERS WILL BE COORDINATED THROUGH THE APPROPRIATE BATTALION CHIEF.
